

Text Readability

Is the readability of items at an appropriate level for the credential?

- Compared readability of Architect Registration Examination item text to that of print architectural resources
 - Word length
 - · Word complexity
 - Sentence length
- Results supported item text as appropriate
- Constraints:
 - Purpose of readability formulas
 - · Format & amount of required text

Graphic Readability

Is the "readability" level of item graphics (tables, drawings, photos) appropriate for the target candidates of the credential?

- · Created a definition of graphic readability
 - · Familiarity of content and terminology
 - Information presentation and concepts
 - Comprehension requirements (subject matter knowledge and external information)
- Developed a rubric for SME review and evaluation
- Results:
 - Identified areas for improvement of graphics
 - Guide future selection and development
